Re: Turitea Final Decision

Thank you for your correspondence to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA), received on the 30 September, 2, 3 and 4 October and the prior correspondence sent to the Environment Court, regarding the Final Report and Decision of the Turitea Wind Farm Board of Inquiry.

Under the Resource Management Act, the Board of Inquiry was appointed to consider and make a decision on the Turitea Wind Farm proposal. Once the Board has issued its final decision it has completed its statutory responsibilities and the decision is final and cannot be re-litigated, except on points of law within 15 working days of receiving notification of the decision. The conditions of consent issued with the decision will be administered by the relevant local authorities.

I am aware you will also be receiving a response from the Minister for the Environment and the Ministry for the Environment in regards to your correspondence to them.
